



Dear Tutor

As many of you are aware, the final Grade 12 examination must be written at a SACAI-approved NSC examination centre. This year, in particular, they are faced with a few challenges which have led to a desperate need for venues in the following areas:

- Velddrif (Western Cape)
- Pietermaritzburg (KZN inland)
- George/Mosselbay (Western Cape)
- Upington (Northern Cape)
- Ladysmith (KZN inland)
- Rustenburg (North West)
- Potchefstroom (North West)
- Walkerville/Roodepoort (Gauteng)
- North Riding (Gauteng)
- Eastern Cape

In terms of regulations by Umalusi, SACAI may **NOT** establish venues where:

- The venue is owned by a tutor or private school owner
- The venue is registered as a private school or public school
- The venue is not within 3 to 5 km of a tutor centre, private school or public school
- There are **NO** authorized testing centres in Namibia.

SACAI is asking for our assistance in recommending venues such as church halls, civic and community centres etc., that adhere to the following requirements:

- capacity should allow for a distance of 1.5 metres between candidates writing the exam;
- Health and Fire Safety certificate in place;
- is at least 3 to 5 km away from a school (private or public) or any tutor centre;
- where independent invigilators, who are not associated with any private or public school or tutor centre, will invigilate;

- is available for the full duration of the examination (6 to 7 weeks); and
- has tables, chairs, and clocks available.
